Try a mixed-species grazing program using cattle and goats. Alternate the pasture with a short-cycle crop, such as chicory, when possible. Incorporate plants with anthelmintic properties, including plants rich in condensed tannin (such as *Sericea lespedeza*), in the diet of dairy goats and sheep.

Q fever is a disease caused by a type of bacterium named *Coxiella burnetii*. It is primarily a disease of cattle, sheep, and goats although other livestock and pets can also get Q Fever. The disease in people ranges from asymptomatic to severe. Most animals have no symptoms but infection may cause abortion in sheep and goats.
