There are clear indications that Moses wrote the first five books of the Bible (Genesis to Deuteronomy), sometimes called “the “Pentateuch,” “Torah,” or “the books of Moses.” Those five books were like one unit, so references to Moses as the writer of the law (Numbers 33:2; Joshua 23:6; John 7:22; Mark 12:26) would point to him as the writer of all five of those books.
